Oral Surgery for the General Practitioner Made Easy
with Robert R. Edwab, DMD

Session Description

Make your oral surgeries productive and uneventful with Dr. Robert Edwab, who will share the lessons he has learned from 30 years of private oral surgery practice. He will review a complete office visit, starting with a basic health history to help you decide whether to treat or refer. Procedures for root removal, alveoplasties, frenectomies, biopsies, apicoectomies, impaction removals, and tori reductions will be discussed. The program includes a presentation of the basic principles of performing an incision and drainage and when to refer to avoid spreading space infections. Dr. Edwab will describe ways to avoid and treat surgical complications and review a simple technique to quickly calculate a safe dose of local anesthetic for adults and children.

1. Determine who to treat and who needs a medical consultation
2. Describe what drugs are needed in a medical emergency
3. Demonstrate the proper usage of oral surgery instruments
4. Identify the maximum dosages of local anesthetics to avoid an overdose

6. Apply effective methods for avoiding surgical complications

Dr. Edwab is a board-certified oral and maxillofacial surgeon who has been in private practice for over 30 years. He has lectured on basic oral surgery for the general practitioner at many of the largest dental meetings, both nationally and internationally. He is known for his humor, enthusiasm, and ability to demystify office procedures so they can be performed by any competent general practitioner. He also is Executive Director of the Greater New York Dental Meeting.
